This ToT offers you a unique opportunity to become a climate change leader in your community. With the use of an action-oriented toolkit, you will learn how to train community groups in developing their own climate change projects. The best community projects will have the chance to receive a financial award to fund implementation in 2017.

WHAT CAN YOU LEARN?

Participants will undergo a three-day ToT workshop in Kwale. The workshop will equip participants with practical tools and guidelines on how to develop local climate change projects. It will further enable participant to train community groups in the acquired methods and tools. An outcome of this ToT would be that local communities are able develop climate action initiatives that can be piloted with a financial award from the V-LED project.
